To the honorable William Stougton Esq. the Council: and reprefentatives in general coucl affembled, the humble petition of Matthew Mayhew reprefentative from Marthas Vineyard and James Coffin reprefentative of Nantuckett humbly sheweth

whereas great inconveniences and difturbance hath often happened to the \sim inhabitants of Dukes Countie, And Nantuket both by the Indians themselves, in smale boates Bring rumme fiders and other ftrong drink from Rhode Island, and often purchase= ing the fame on Bord Vefels, coming into the harbor, or lying neer the shores of Said ~ Islands, Hereby Caufeing much drunkenness, among the indians, which often ocasions difturbance not only to the fober indians, who complaine thereof, but likewife to the English, and may prove an ocasion of discord by outrages committed by the indians while a great number are in drink, wee pray the fame may bee remedied, by fome ord of this great and generall Court, and humbly propose that if an act should be made for hindering the importation of anee rumme, fider or ftrong drink there, in greater or less quantities, Except landed at the harbot by anee indians on penaltie of forfitting the fame and the valu. and that the justice of peace in selfions may impower, the severall indian Constables to seiz the same, or English Constables, or that by virtue of an act &c, order ye Indian or English constable should have power to seiz such strong drink, and wee humbly ~ concieve if the one Moyetie bee to the informer and officer that so seiz it may be a great meanes to remedee fo great an eevel partly alreddy happened & growing dayly uppon the faid places: having formerly had Experience of the fame; which humbly laying before this hono.^{bl} Court --fhall alwase pray
