The humble petition of ^{^us} the fubcribing Indians
Proprietors of Lands in Punkapoag
Sheweth That ^{^wee} Your pet^{rs} have about fifteen
hundred Acres of Land yet remaining
unfol in Punkapoag or Dorchester
Village fo Called; and by reafon that [*overwritten: they*] we
are fo few in number [*overwritten: they*] we are not
able to fettle more than a thoufand
Acres of it if fo much which Confideration
Inclines [*overwritten: them*] us to fell five hundred
Acres of the s^d Land ~

Wherefore we Your pet^{rs} Pray Your
Honours will Allow John wentworth will Sherman
will wheler fam^{ll} hartwell Sileas Crane
(who are our Neighbours
& have been our kind Friends in many
Instances) to buy five hundred Acres of
Land, (which they propofe to fettle upon)
for.
