To the Honourable Generall Afsembly to be holden att  
Newhaven on the 2<sup>d</sup> Thursday of October 1731

The Memoriall of the Pequott Indians belonging  
to the Town of Groton, the Subscribers hereunto in the  
behalf of themselves and the Rest of the Pequott Ind-  
ians Humbly Sheweth that Whereas the Honourable  
Generall Afsembly at Harford in May last, took  
Care of your Memoriallists and Appointed us Overseers  
to take Care of us that wee Should not be wronged of Our  
Land. Wee do Return the Honourable Afsembly Thanks  
for there Care of us, and Do further pray that for as much  
as Our Overseers in the Memoriall preferr'd for us; there  
was Six hundred Acres of Our Land that was Sett Out  
to us by the Same Comitee and in the Same Deed left  
out of said Memoriall and So Nothing Acted on it by the  
said Afsembly in May last. Your Memoriallists  
therefore Humbly Pray that said six hundred Acres of  
Land may be put under the Same Regulation as the  
other Lands are at Mashantuxitt and that Our Over-  
=seers may have the Same power to take Care of our Interest  
there for Our Ufe as they have of the Lands at Mashan-  
=tuxitt and Whereas it Appears on the Records of the Town  
of Groton that there is About fourty or more Deeds of Our  
Lands on Record. wherein the granters have pretended to pass  
the fee of Our Lands one to Another. your Memoriallists Hum-  
=bly pray that your Honours woulde Enact Something in our  
favour Respecting Said Deeds. and youer Memoriallists as in  
Duty bound Shall pray - Groton October the 7<sup>th</sup>. 1731
