Amounting to y<sup>e</sup> Sum of Eleven pounds  
and one fhilling being a Charge Occa=  
-fioned by the Sicknefs and funeral of  
of Zach.<sup>a</sup> Quack who was a Prop.<sup>tr</sup>  
of said Punkapogg. Now for as much  
as your Mem.<sup>st</sup> has not any of the the In=  
-terest Money belonging to the Indians  
in hand; but for many years past  
has been and Still is in Advance to  
them

much Difficulty ) be avoided by reafon  
of the needy Circumstances of the Indians  
Calling for frequent Supplys by your Mem.<sup>st</sup>  
Who therefore lays the matter before Your  
Excellency and Hon.<sup>ty</sup> for your Consideration  
whether it may not be Convenient to Allow  
the payment of Said Acc.<sup>t</sup> or Such part there=  
-of as shall be judged reafonable out of the  
principall money which is about Seven hund.<sup>d</sup>  
and Sixteen pounds, Which is humbly  
Submitted by your Mem.<sup>st</sup>
