heare is complaint come is to this Honoured Genald corld as to what Einglish do to Indions at Nantuckket they let them have money and Goods and Indians are sent whaling and fifhing and when Indions are at home then they most wark for ther masters and they will not give Indions account what they git at such time whaling or fishing and let Indion live as long as he will and when he Tye Einglish will tak all what it may be fount to be his Estate and Einglish will leave nothing for Indions wifes or children and so they be come poor and we poor Indions at Nantuckket Defire this favour of you Chentilmen of Genald Corld that the Indion may haue account to be made up to him to so what he is In Debed to his said masters we pray that this may be Granted by you Chintilmen of Gerald Corld to we poor Indions at Nantuckket Dated In June 1st 1749~ Paul Quaab
