The Petition of Michael Bacon of Needham in the County of Suffolk Yeoman, Humbly Sheweth

That one Allexander Quapish a Poor Indian A Belonging to this State who was taken Sick in the Army Near Cambridge & was Dismissed, Came to the House of your Petitioner Ain Said Needham in a Suffering Condition the 15th Day of November 1775 And Remained there Asick untill the 23 day of March 1776 and then Died, and as your Petitioner was at Great Trouble & Charge in Boarding, Nursing, & Burying Said Indian he Humbly Prays your Honour to take his Case into your wise Consideration & allow his account therefore which he hath Charged at a very low Rate, & order him to be Paid the Same out of the Publick Treasury & as in Duty Bound shall ever Pray,
