To the H[hole] General Afsembly now Sitting at NewHaven the Petition of Nathaniel Stevens^{116a} and John Holabird Selectmen in and for the Town of Canaan and Joseph North and Bradley Catlin Selectmen in and for the Town of Cornwell would represent to this Honoble Afsembly that on the 8.th of May 1802 one Molly Meason an Indian woman came into said Town of Canaan and was thin taken sick whereupon she became chargeable to said Town of Canaan for board Attendence and Medicens to the Amount of Thirty one Dollars and fifty three Cents -- and the Petitioners would further state that on the 17th of June she left said Canaan and went into the Town of Cornwell where she continued to be sick and soon after died and the Town of Cornwell expended for board Attendanc medicen and funral expences to the Amount of Twenty Dollars and fifty nine Cents -- and the Petitioners would further repre= =sent to this Afsembly that the said Molly owned in fee at her deceased an undivided share of a Small peace of land lying in the Town of Farmington and your Petitioners would pray your Honers to appoin [hole] ome suitable person with full powers to s[hole]l and convey so much of her said land as will pay said Debts with the incident charges and to pay the avails thereof over to the descharge of the aforesaid Debt. (if their should be a Suffcency to pay and discharge the whch) or so far as the avails thereof will go in prepotision to their Debts or in some other way grant relief to your Petitioners as to your Honers shall appear just & right and your Petitioners in duty bound will ever ¹⁴Ĩ pray
