To his Excellency the Governor of the Commonwealth of Maſsachusetts, and the Honourable Council The memorial of the undersigners, indian natives and Pepole of colour, being tenants in Common in the Indian Lands on the Island of Chapequidick in the County of Dukes County Humbly shew, That the said Land set off to the Indians & to be holden as aforesaid

under the care and oversight of Guardians agreeable to an act passed January 26th day AD 1789, has been improved from said time by the Indians inhabiting the same. till lately interrupted, by a few of the heads of several famalies being women. who openly avowed from time to time that they would not be governed by the regulations of the Guardians in the division of the Lands for improvement Severally allotted to them, but with force have intruded and forced others to abandon their improvements, to their great injury, which has occasioned much Ill will & some Litigation, your memorialists are of Opinion that the said Law is wisely intended for our Benefit and happiness nither do we wish the same abrogated, Yet nevertheless if your Exellency and Honours in your wisdom conceive that any further additional Law may be necessa[torn] =rv to Govern and regulate the impro[*torn*] =ment of said Lands for the advantage of the whole under the care & oversight of Guardians, we shall consider our = =selves in duty bound to ever pray -Chapequiddick May 22nd 1809.
