

May y^e 22: 1673: Whereas there hath been A former Contract or Bargain Betwixt our Hon^d frind m^r John Haynes, Esq^r formerly of Hartford, deceafed, on the one Partie for y^e Town of Farmington & Pethers, Sachem of Tunkses Sepus In y^e Name & with y^e Confent of y^e Reft of y^e Indians then In Being as by our former Writting Doth Plainly appear Bareing Date april y^e 9th 1650: yett Notwithstanding In procefs of time sum dissatisfaction growing amongst y^e Indians In Respect to y^e Premifses upon which account y^e Town of Farmington Gave them A meeting by A Committee wherein they came to a frindly agreement and final Conclusion to wit A Ratification & confirmation of y^e forementioned Writting To Say the Bounds of Farmington as Now they are Layd out by order of Court which shall more fully appear by A figure hereafter Incerted, which we y^e afores^d Indians Do freely, fully absolutly & forever Remit Release Relinquilh and Pasfover, by this our act & Deed unto y^e Town of Farmington or them theyer heirs succesors forever firmly by thefe presents Rati= fying and Confirming y^e same by this Instrument to the Town of Farmington & to theyer heirs and succesors forever Warranting & afsur= ing them that we have full Right, title & power to Confirm y^e same to them as afores^d & by thefe presents Bind our selves heirs & succesors to free y^e afores^d Lands from all molestation or Incumberance from by o under any person or persons whatfoever and Give them hereby true Right, title Claim & Intereft in y^e same & power to Record it to them selves or succesors whatfoever as they shall fee meet, according to Law to Do - the Town of Farmington freely Giveing to y^e Indians- afores^d 200 two hundred acres of Land within y^e Bounds of theyer- plantation as allfo three pounds In other pay which Land afores^d is given upon the Conditions following viz. that this Land the English do here engage y^e Indians not to make any sale thereof But keep it for y^e ufe & Benefit of themfelves & theyer Posterity and alfo they are hereby engaged when they plant or Improve this Land now Given them that they shall secure themfelves by A sufficient fence which Land they have all ready pitcht upon to y^e full Content & Satisfaction of all y^e Indians who are hereafter Incerted & Now forth =with to be measured out to them, & to y^e true & faithfull performance hereof & every part hereof we bind ourselves our heris Execut^{rs} Administ^{rs} & assigns. In witness hereunto we enterchangably sett to our hands y^e Day & year afores^d:- the words (to say) Betwixt y^e 11: & 12 lines was Before signing-----
