Remainder & Remainders Rents yearly profits and aditions whatsoever, percells of Land, and Singuler ye deeds & Evidences Touching or Concerning ye Evidences, or any part of them to have & to hold to ye sd Thomas Bird his heirs & assignes, and to the onely proper use & behoof, of ye sd Thomas Bird his heirs & assigns forever: and ye sd Toms Squoow, doth Covenant & promise to & with. the sd Thomas Bird that. She ye sd Toms Squoow hath. full power. Good Right at ye Signing of these present. to Sell ye Same and every part of them, and that ye premifes shall from henceforth, and forever Remaine & Continue unto ye sd Thom-=as Bird, freely acquited and Clearly discharged, of and from all maner of former & other Bargains and Sales, Gifts, Grants Don =ors Joynters. Leafes. Rents. Charges. ufes. Intails. Judgments forfeatures. exicutions. mortgages. fines. Issues & Incumbrances what-=foever, had been made or Committed, or willingly or Willingly Suffered to be done, by ye sa Toms Squoow, her heirs & exicutrs adminisrs or assignes, or by her or theyer means. Consent, privity or procurement, or by any other person, or persons. whatfoever Lawfully Claiming by, from, or under her or hers, or any of them, and that ye aforesd percelfs of Land shall at ye Cost of ye sd Thomas Bird, be enrolled or Recorded to him In ye Book of Records, of Land for ffarmington, for ye proper use. & behoof him ye sd ye sd Thomas Bird. - In Wittness whereof I. ye aforesd Toms Squoow. hath Signed.
