 Taunton and Middleburrrough within the sd Province  
 which of right (descended unto the sd Abigail only  
 daughter and sole Heirefs of Josiah y<sup>e</sup> Sachem dec<sup>d</sup>)  
 by Bridgewatermen in the Province aforesd laying  
 claime to, and holding the same without any grant  
 from y<sup>e</sup> said Sachem Josiah Proprieto:<sup>r</sup> or his right=  
 full Heires Yo<sup>r</sup> Petition<sup>rs</sup> humby pray the  
 Considercõ of yo<sup>r</sup> Ex:<sup>cy</sup> and Hono<sup>rs</sup> that they may en=  
 joy and quietly pofsefse their abovementioned right
