Benefit & Behoof forever. Furthermore I. ye fall Stephen Indian Do. hereby Covenant promife & engage for my felfe heirs &c to & with him ye sd Timō. Indian. that att ye time of ye Enfeof= =ing of these presents. I. am and stand Lawfully seised of ye premises In my own. Right In Fee. and that ye premises fhall. from henceforth Remain & Continue to ve only proper use Benefit & Behoof, of him ve sd Timothy Indian his heirs & assigns forever, against ye Lawfull Claims or Demands, of any person or persons, whatsoever, forever hereafte to War= =rant fecure & Defend.
