 =pafsover Convay and Confirm unto him y^e s^d Timothy Indian his heirs & afsigns forever one piece of Land Lying in y^e Town=
 =ship of Farmington afores^d. Containing by Eftimation about one acre of Land. Lying on y^e hill on y^e West fid of paquabuk
 meadow nigh y^e Wigwams. on which Land Standeth about fourty foure apple trees: Bounded Eaft on y^e Brow of y^e hill South
 and West on my own Land. North on y^e Land of James Wawowis. and for y^e f^d Timō. Indian. his heirs & afsigns to have & to
 hold f^d Given & Granted premifes. with all y^e appurtenances priveledges & Commodities to y^e Same belonging or In any
 wife appertaining to his and thayer proper ufe. Benefit & Behoof forever. Furthermore I. y^e f^d Stephen Indian Do.
 hereby Covenant promife & engage for my felfe heirs &c to & with him y^e s^d Timō. Indian. that att y^e time of y^e Enfeof=
 =ing of these presents. I. am and ftand Lawfully feifed of y^e premifes In my own. Right In Fee. and that y^e premifes
 fhall. from henceforth Remain & Continue to y^e only proper ufe Benefit & Behoof. of him y^e s^d Timothy Indian his heirs
 & afsigns forever. againft y^e Lawfull Claims or Demands. of any person or persons. whatsoever, forever hereafte to War=
 =rant secure & Defend. In Confirmation Whereof. I. have hereunto fixed my hand & feal. this firft Day of april, & In y^e year
 of our Lord A.D. 1740:
