Formerly of s^d Farmington dec.^d at a place. Called Fort Hill as it Lyeth undivided with the Remainder of Said Twenty Acres the whole being Butted & Bounded as followeth Eaft with the Rang where the old Common fence formerly stood weft with the Common fence where it now Stands North with the River South with Land belonging to the heirs of Jonathan Barns Decd

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above Granted and Bargained Premiffes, with the Appurtenances thereof, unto *him* the faid *Elijah Weampy his*

Heirs and Affigns forever, toand their own proper Ufe and Behoof.And also, I the faid Solomon HartDo for my felf & my Heirs,Executors and Adminiftrators, Covenant with the faid Elijah Weampy his

Heirs and Affigns, That at and until the Enfealing of thefe Prefents, *I am* well Seifed of the Premiffes, as a good indefeafible Eftate in Fee Simple; and have good Right to Bargain and Sell the fame in Manner and Form as is above Written; and that the fame is free of all Incumbrances whatfoever. AND FURTHERMORE, *I* the faid *Solomon Hart* –

do by thefe Prefents, bind *my* fel*fe* and *my* Heirs for ever, to Warrant and Defend the above Granted and Bargained premiffes, to *him* the faid *Elijah Weampy his* ---- Heirs and Affigns, againft all Claims and Demands whatfoever.
