Do give, grant, bargain, fell, and confirm unto the faid Samuel Adams & to his Heirs & Afigns forever; All my Right Title & Interefts in & of one Certain Lott of Land in ye Bounds Of s.d Farmington being ye 52d Lott in N.o in ye Southeaft Devefion So Called Containing in ye whole twenty two Acres three Rood & 28 perches Laid out to Jacob Bromfon Formerly of s.d Farmington being one of ye eighty four proprietors of s.d Town And my proportion thereof being Nine Acres two Roods & Eight perches being one fourth & one Sixth Parts of sd Lott Lying in Common with Other prefent proprietors of s.d Land; which Lott is Butted & Bounded as by Record may Appear;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above granted and bargained Premifes, with the Appurtenances thereof, unto *him* the faid *Sam^{II} Adams to his* Heirs

and Affigns forever, to his and their own proper Ufe and Behoof. And alfo, I the faid $Elnathan\ Gridley$ do for my felf Heirs, Executors and Administrators, covenant with the faid $Sam^{||}$ $Adams\ his\ Heirs$

Heirs and Affigns, that at and until the enfealing of these Presents, *I am* well seized of the Premises, as a good indeseasible Estate in Fee-simple; and have good Right to bargain and sell the same in Manner and Form as is above written; and that the same is free of all Incumbrances whatsoever. And Furthermore, *I* the said *Elnathan Gridley*

do, by these Presents, bind *my* self & *my* Heirs forever, to Warrant and Defend the above-granted and bargained Premises, to the said *Sam^{II} Adams his*

Heirs and Affigns, againft all Claims and Demands whatfoever.
