 resenting that the Mem.<sup>is</sup> have A Small  
 interest in Lands value about thirty pounds  
 lately adjudged to them by this Afsembly  
 which on Account of their <sup>present</sup> Situation being  
 removed away from S.<sup>d</sup> East Haven they  
 are Deserous of Selling praying to be Enabled  
 to make Sale of their Said remaining right  
 & interest under the direction of Some Suitable  
 person and the purchase monies in like  
 manner to be laid out & Disposed of

Resolved by this Afsembly that the S.<sup>d</sup>  
 Adam Indian for himself & the Rest of the  
 Said Tribe be and he is hereby Authorised & fully  
 impowerd & Enabled to make Sale by Deed  
 in Common & Usual form of all Such rem  
 aining right [ *illegible* ] in the S.<sup>d</sup> Indian Lands at  
 East Haven afor<sup>d</sup> Under the direction & by and  
 with the Consent & Concurrence of Sam<sup>l</sup> Bifhop  
 Esq<sup>r</sup> of New Haven <sup>& John Strong Esq<sup>r</sup> of Farmington</sup> who are herby Authorised &  
 Desired to Afsist him the S.<sup>d</sup> Adam accordingly  
<sup>in the S<sup>d</sup> matter</sup> <sup>^</sup> and the monies that Shall be raised by Such  
 Sale the S.<sup>d</sup> Adam by the Consent & allowance of y<sup>e</sup>  
 y<sup>e</sup> S.<sup>d</sup> ~~Mess<sup>rs</sup>~~ Bifhop <sup>^</sup> & Strong <sup>is</sup> herby Enabled to lay out
