full Satisfaction, of *Fisher Gay of s.^d Farmington one of ye Comtee Appointed by ye Generall Assembly
in May Laft to Recive & Lay out ye Money Belonging to ye Indians to the best Advantage of the
Decendant of the Tunkcifs Tribe in Farmington*

Do Give, Grant, Bargain, Sell, and Confirm unto the said *Elijah Weampy
Solomon Maufuck & James Wowowous And to ye Rest of ye Indians Decendants
of ye Originall Tunkcifs Tribe of Indians in s.^d Farmington Two peaces or
percells of Land Laying in s.^d Farmington, One of s.^d percells of Land lyeth
in ye 8th Allotment in ye Second Devifion Land laying west of ye Reserved Land
in s.^d Farmington and Contains Thirty Six Acres & One Rood as ye Same lyeth
undivided, and the whole Lott is Butted East & west on Highways, North on ye
Seventh Lott in s.^d Devifion ~ The Other peace is Twenty one Acres of
Land in ye 49th Lott in N^e in ye Devifion Called ye Southeaft Devifion which
was Drawn on ye Right of Thomas Barns, And Lyeth Undevided & ye whole Lott
is Butted & Bounded As followeth (Viz) East & west on Highways North on
the 48th Lott & South on ye 50th Lott in s.^d Devifion –*

To Have and to hold the above Granted and Bargained Premifes, with
the Appurtenances thereof, unto *them* the said *Elijah &c: and ye Decendants of s.^d Tribe*

their Heirs and Affigns for ever, to *them* and their own proper Ufe and Behoof.
And also, *I* the said *Elnathan Gridley*

do for my self & my Heirs,
Executors and Adminiftrators, Covenant with the said *Elijah Solomon & James &
ye Rest of ye Decendants of ye Tunkcifs Tribe And with their*

Heirs and Affigns, That at and until the Enfealing of these Presents *I am*
well feized of the Premifes as a good indefeasible Estate in Fee-simple; and have good

Right to Bargain and Sell the same in Manner and Form as is above Written; and that the same is free of all Incumbrances whatsoever. And Furthermore, *I* the said *Elnathan Gridley* do by these Presents, bind *my self* and *my Heirs* for ever, to WARRANT and Defend the above Granted and Bargained Premises, to *them* the said *Elijah Solⁿ & James & the Rest of y^e Decendents of y^e Afores.^d Tribe ~*
And to their Heirs and Assigns, against all Claims and Demands whatsoever. In Witness Whereof, *I* have hereunto set *my* Hand and Seal the 18th Day of *May* In the 10th Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord *George the third* of Great-Britain, &c. KING, Anno Domini, 1770:
