To the Honorable Board of Councellors for the State of Maſsachuſsets Bay : and to the Hono rable Houſe of Repreſentatives of the Same that will meet in Gen^{II} Court the Laſt Wenesday in may next.

The humble petition of the Joseph Richards Noah Wepquish & others principal Proprietors natives & Inhabitants of Mashpee in the County of Barnstable & state of Massachusets Bay, humbly sheweth.

That whereas our faithful & beloved pastor Rev.^d M^r Gideon Hawley hath spent his days is civilizing & gospelizing the Indians and in Serving them in deverfe ways & manners and is yet in that work, we the subfcibers and others at a Proprietors meeting held in the District on the 23rd day of March appointed a Committee to confer with our said minister respecting making him and his heirs a grant of our property for his fu ture encouragement in our service in this time of difficulty, and have this day accepted the report of the said Committee in a full meeting of the Proprietors, a Copy of which attefted by our Clerk we shall send herewith. We petition the great & general Court of this State that we the proprie tors may be authorized by then to give the s^d Gideon Hawley a good deed of said Lands & meadow as therein mentioned with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belong ing and your petitioners as in duty bound will always pray
