In the Houfe of the Repreferitave Febr y<sup>e</sup> 4. 1782  
on the petition of Desire Cepit praying that She  
may be impow<sup>d</sup> to make fale of fome part of the  
whole of about two Hundred acres of poor pine  
Land lying and being in the Town of Plyimton in  
the County of Plymouth or that she might be  
Relived in fome other way ---

Resolved that John Turner Efqr David Kingman  
Gentleman & John Nelson Efqr - - gardiens to the  
Plymouth Tribe of Indains fo called be and here  
by are impowed to make fale of fo much  
of the afore faid two Hundred acers of pine  
Land belonging to the faid Defire as may be  
Sufficient to Difcharge her Juft Deptes, &  
to fuport her, in her advanced age - they,  
the afore faid Gardiens - to account for  
the Proceeds that may arife upon fuch  
Sale agreeable to the Law in that Cafe  
made and prvided
