TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above granted and bargained Premises, with the Appurtenances thereof, unto *him* the said *Timothy Root & to his*

Heirs and Affigns

forever, to *his* and their own proper Use and Behoof. And also, *I* the said *Elijah Weampey*

do for my fel f and my

Heirs, Executors and

Administrators, covenant with the said Timothy Root his

Heirs and Affigns; that at and until the enfealing of these Presents, *I am* well fiezed of the Premises, as a good indeseassible Estate in Fee-simple, and have good Right to bargain and sell the same in Manner and Form as is above written, and that the same is free of all Incumbrances whatsoever.

do by these Presents, bind *my* self *and my* Heirs forever to Warrant and Desend the above granted and bargained Premises, to *him* the said *Timothy Root his*

Heirs and Affigns, againft all Claims and Demands whatfoever.
