and to his Heirs & Afsigns forever a part of a Two rod Highway lying
on the weft Side of the Grant Afores.^d being at the North Side of
the Highway Afores.^d Croft s^d Grant by the Selectment & from
thence runs North to the North Side of his Land Lying weft of s.^d
Highway And Contains About Two roods Butting weft on his own
Land South on Highway Eaft on s.^d Grant (*erasure*:ed) & North on Land Laid
out of s.^d Highway to Cap.^t Root. To have & to Hold the
Above Granted & Bargained premifes with the Appurtenances thereof
unto him the s.^d Mausuck and to his Heirs & Afsigns forever to his &
their own proper Ufe & Behoof and also we the s.^d Com^{tee} Do for
our Selves and our Succesors Covenant with him the s^d Mausuck
and his Heirs & Afsigns that the Above Granted premifes Shall
forever Remain a Good perfect and Absolute Eftate in fee Simple
by him & them to be Injoyed as their own forever & the Same is free
of All Incumbrances Whatsoever in Confirmation whereof we have
Hereunto to Set our hands & Seals the 27th Day of Feb.^r AD 1789
