

Upon the memorial of the Selectmen of the Town of Guilford -- shewing to this Assembly that s.^d Town expended a large sum in supporting Ann Tanterpan an Indian ¹⁴⁹ Squaw who died entiteld to no estate except about two acres of land lying Thirty Miles Island near the Town of Haddam -- praying for Liberty to sell said Land as per Memorial dated May 12th 1789

Resolved by this Assembly that the Selectmen of the Town of Guilford be and they are hereby impowered and authorised to sell and execute ^a legal conveyance of all the land to which the s.^d Ann Tanterpan at the time of her decease had a good and lawful Right and title on s.^d Thirty Miles Island and to dispose of the monies arising from the sale thereof towards defraying the expences of supporting s.^d Ann by s.^d Town
