Respectfully shews Moses Roberts of Grafton in the County of Worcester that he is the Trustee of the Hasanamisco or Grafton Indians one of whom by the name of Moses Gimbo died a few years since in the Town of Worcester having a dwelling house and garden and about a quarter of an acre of land besides and having also a widow and two one child viz Ony Gimbo .& Leander Gimbo & Caroline Belden wife of James Belden, And your petition shews that the dwelling house aforesaid is now out of repair and in order to be tenantable it requires to be repaired and no means ^{^ are} in your petitioner hands for making such repairs unlefs he can be permitted to dispose of a part of the land aforesaid. He therefore prays that he may be authorized and empowered to sell

the aforesaid quarter of an acre of land belonging to the estate of said deceased and that the proceeds thereof may be applied so far as necessary in repairing said house & the remainder if any be held by your petitioner for the benefit of all persons interested in said estate
