the dwelling house aforesaid is now out
of repair and in order to be tenant-
able it requires to be repaired and
no means ^{are} in your petitioner hands
for making such repairs unless he
can be permitted to dispose of a
part of the land aforesaid. He
therefore prays that he may be
authorized and empowered to sell

land belonging to the estate of said deceased
and that the proceeds thereof may be
applied so far as necessary in repairing
said house & the remainder if any
be held by your petitioner for the
benefit of all persons interested in
said estate
