

To the Honorable Senate and House of
Representatives in General Court. Assembled

We the undersigned beg respectfully to represent that from certain grants, deeds, and conveyances as well as from Original Rights (Copies of conveyances being hereunto annexed) that certain Indian Lands by Original right as well as by conveyances do by Law and usage rightfully belong to the heir or heirs of Quachatason Indian Sachem formerly of Sandwich, County of Barnstable in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts said parcels of Lands, rights and privileges now being in the County of Plymouth Commonwealth aforesaid and one Hannah Seppet [^]now wife of Augustus Casey of carver in said County claims to be the true heir to said lands with the rights and privileges, also to Land rights and privileges laid out and granted to one Samuel Sonowot and Dorothy his wife pursuant to a vote of the Town of Plymouth July 13th AD. 1705. as will appear by a Copy of Certificate of Surveyors hereto annexed and together with all other Lands rights and privileges that may be found belonging to said Claimant as heir (or to other lawful heirs if any should appear) either by Law equity usage Grants Conveyances Or otherwise, the possessor of said lands rights and privileges having been often requested by the said Claimant His or her lawful representative her Husband Augustus Casey, to Surrender to her the rightful Owner of Said lands rights and privileges. they the occupants and possessors thereof refuse So to so to the injury of the said claimant as heir thereto. Now we the undersigned petitioners ask your Honorable Body to take the matter into due consideration and adopt such measures as shall enable the said Hannah or her lawful Attorney or representation to become repossessed of all and singular the Lands rights and privileges tot he said claimant heir, belonging and also that your acts and doings may extend to any lawful heirs to the aforesaid Lands rights and privileges if any shall appear. We respectfully submit this Our petition with Copies of documents annexed for your due deliberation and action in behalf of the aforenamed Hannah and others. And as in duty bound shall ever pray
