of the Commonwealth of Mafsachusetts

The undersigned respectfully represents that he  
is a Member of the Ponkapog tribe of Indians, that he is  
granted by the Commonwealth an annuity of fifty Dollars  
per year during his life - that he is blind and unable  
to do anything for his support. and that said sum of fifty  
dollars annually is Now insufficient for his support.

Wherefore he prays that an additional sum May  
be granted to him payable to the Guardian of said  
tribe to be by him Expended for the benefit of your  
petitioner and as in duty bound will Ever pray.
